

Five Long-Term Care Facts You Need to Know

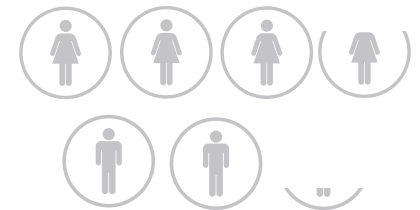
What are the real odds you'll need long-term care?

On average, women need care (3.7 years) longer than men (2.2 years).

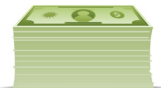


How would you manage long-term care if you or a loved one needed it?
